Here's a little history of how Illinois became a state.

On April 18, 1818, Congress passed the *Illinois Enabling Act*, which provided for the organization of a state government, fixed the northern boundary of Illinois and established a permanent school fund from a portion of the proceeds from the sale of public lands.

On August 26, 1818 the Illinois Constitutional Convention, meet at Kaskaskia, adopted a State Constitution and selected Kaskaskia as the first state capital.

Paris, IL Daily Beacon News (Thursday, March 6, 1941)

Funeral rites for Miss Mary Jane Welch, 83, 406 East Wood street, who died at 2:30 o'clock on Wednesday afternoon at Vermilion County hospital, Clinton, Ind., will be held at 2:30 o'clock on Friday afternoon at the Frist funeral home, Clinton. Burial will be at Riverside cemetery.

Miss Welch resided in Clinton before coming to Paris 15 years ago. She had been a hospital patient since November 1. She was born on January 11, 1858, a daughter of Nelson and Fanna Farnham Welch.

The following nieces are surviving: Mrs. Ethel **Timmerman** and Mrs. Warren **Harrison**, both of Clinton and Mrs. Charles Harris, East Wood street, Paris. She was a member of Trinity Methodist church in Clinton.
